1. Night, weekend and holiday healthcare:

Out of hours services:

- Monday to Friday: 18.00-8.00 (6 p.m. – 8 a.m.)
- Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays: 24 hours,

To obtain medical care you need to have:

- Identification (passport, student ID),
- PESEL number (applies to patients over 3 months old),
- Patients insured by military services (army, police, border guard) are advised to have a valid insurance document,
- Patients using EHIC card (European Health Insurance Card) are requested to present it with a valid ID,
- Patients with chronic diseases are advised to bring original packaging of their medications.

- Elective admissions for patients with hospital referral,
- Life-threatening emergency admissions,

- Emergency admissions for patients with sudden health problems (no hospital referral required).

- Preliminary diagnostic testing incl. laboratory and radiology,
- Preliminary health condition assessment,
- Short observation care,
- Medical transport for patients transferred to other facilities,
- Air transport.
